



## **Lomond School Means Tested Scholarships 2024-25**

### **General Information**

Following the success of the Scholarship Programme launched on the back of the school's 40th Anniversary Celebrations we are now welcoming Scholarship applications for August 2025 entry for day and boarding pupils from Senior 1 to Senior 6.

It is our wish to offer the unique Lomond School experience to those young people who may not ordinarily have the means or opportunity to access it, and a range of Scholarships will be awarded for the duration of full-time education.

Scholarships are categorised as follows:

- Academic Excellence
- Music
- The Creative Arts
- Sport
- The David Arthur All-Rounder Scholarship

The awarding of Scholarships is dependent on entry criteria and all scholarships will be means-tested. A reduction of up to 50% of tuition / school fees may be available depending on individual circumstances.

The bestowal of any Scholarship carries with it privilege and responsibility. Every Scholarship holder is expected to set an example for other pupils in their conduct and approach to academic study, and participate in the fuller life of the School, through its programme of extra-curricular activities. The tenure of a Scholarship is intended to be for the duration of the holder's education at Lomond School, provided the holder's academic progress and general conduct remain satisfactory and provided the holder continues, enthusiastically, to fulfil the obligations associated with the Scholarship.

Also available are a generous number of means-tested bursaries which can offer a significant reduction in fees. Please note that bursary applicants are not required to meet the Scholarship criteria.

## Deadline for applications

For those looking for August 2025 entry, the application pack should be completed and submitted for consideration before close of business on Friday, 20 December 2024.

Following submission of applications, Scholarship applicants and their parents/guardians will then be invited to tour the school and meet with the Principal and relevant teaching staff before undertaking interviews, testing and auditions (as appropriate) which will be held in November and May respectively.
