

Lomond School Means Tested Scholarships 2024 Creative Arts

The Creative Arts are a vital part of the curriculum at Lomond School and allow our pupils to develop their self-expression, imagination and confidence. Pupils receive specialist lessons in Art and Drama from Junior 1 and these subjects are both available for pupils to choose as options to S5 and S6 (International Baccalaureate Visual Arts and Theatre). We encourage creativity and expression and there are numerous opportunities for our pupils to perform in plays and musicals or to speak or debate in public. Both our Junior and Senior School have regular publications and we encourage our pupils to write articles for these. We regularly enter pupils for national competitions and have achieved much success in this area.

Scholarships are awarded to pupils who can demonstrate talent in the creative arts. This could be in Creative Writing, Art, Photography or Drama.

Criteria

Pupils will undertake standardised tests in English and Maths. Pupils will also be required to submit a piece of writing and attend an interview. In addition: Art, Photography and Creative Writing scholarship pupils will be expected to submit a folio of work. Drama scholarship pupils will be expected to perform an audition.

Please note that scholarships are awarded by the school's Scholarship Committee and their decision is final. It is not possible to appeal the decision of the committee nor will feedback be given regarding the reasons for their decision. Scholarships are awarded for a specific entry point and cannot be deferred. All scholarships are subject to verification of relevant qualifications and a satisfactory pupil testimonial from the existing school. Acceptance of a scholarship implies consent under the Data Protection Act for the School to keep in contact with the pupil and for the pupil to be published in relevant publicity materials. If an applicant is selected to receive a Scholarship and they choose to decline the Award, then the Scholarship will be void for the academic year of application.

Data Protection
