The fees are inclusive of textbooks, stationery and materials but do not include external examination fees. Note that J1 to T2 pupils can attend school from 8am to 5.30pm with no additional charge.

#### Extra Subjects

English as a second language can be arranged at the below costs:

#### Remission

When three or more members of one family are pupils at the School the two eldest will be charged full fees and the remaining pupils in the family may be eligible for a discount of up to 50% of the tuition fee. If a pupil is already receiving a reduction in fees, the total of the discounts for that individual will be limited to no more than 50%. Generally, no discounts are applied to boarding fees or extras.



#### Methods of Payment

There are several methods of payment that exist for parents when it comes to settling their account for school fees. These options provide the flexibility to pay in full at the beginning of the school year or by two direct debit options.

#### <u>Payment in full at the beginning of the Academic Year</u>

Payment is due in full on or before the first day of the school year. Payment can be made by cheque, internet banking or a bank transfer.

#### Payment by Direct Debit

Payment of fees by instalment can be arranged from the end of May. Payments can be made in 12 instalments starting 28 June 2024 and ending 30 May 2025 or in 10 instalments starting 15 August 2024 and ending 15 May 2025. A direct debit mandate must be completed and sent to the school for processing and all Payers will receive a schedule of dates and amounts due. A direct debit mandate is attached for parents wishing to use this option.

Payment by <u>Overseas Parents</u> may be made by the following methods if the Direct Debit option is unsuitable.

Payment can be made in full or in 3 instalments. Each payment is due <u>before</u> the beginning of each term.

- 1. A Bankers Draft in Sterling made payable to Lomond School Ltd.
- Direct transfer of the <u>Sterling</u> amount payable to the School's Bank Account (details below)
- 3. If a sterling bank account in the UK has been opened, a cheque may be drawn on that bank account.

Parents should consult with their bank as to the most cost effective way to transfer payment to the school. It should be noted that bank charges for the transfer must be covered by the payer.
